**Historic Photo Exhibit Opens at the WDM Moose Jaw
*Adrian Paton Collection Travelling Exhibit***

It's been a labour of love for Arcola resident Adrian Paton. After collecting nearly 8000 photos over a period of more than 20 years, his work is featured in a travelling exhibit, on display at the Western Development Museum – Moose Jaw until February 16, 2017.

The display, developed through a partnership with the Saskatchewan History & Folklore Society (SHFS) and the University of Saskatchewan, features selected photos from the collection along with information designed to inspire people to reflect on the past.
