The WDM Moose Jaw is pleased to present *Akin to the Land: The History of Métis in Southwest Saskatchewan* from April 10 through June 5 at the WDM in Moose Jaw.

Learn about the lives of some of southwest Saskatchewan's earliest residents. From early experiences as bison hunters to contributions to cultural life, this travelling exhibit explores the historical presence of the Métis people. The exhibit features artwork inspired from the history and landscape by Métis artist George Gingras.
