### CAMP X SECRET AGENT SCHOOL AT THE WDM MOOSE JAW

The idea of spies and covert action have become a part of our cultural narrative. In partnership with the Yorkton Film Festival, the Western Development Museum - Moose Jaw presents **Camp X: Secret Agent School** at 2:00 pm on Saturday, February 27.

In 1941, a top secret training facility called Camp X was set up outside Toronto to train secret agents. They were taught how to kill, build bombs, create cover identities and crack codes. The details of what went on there remained classified for decades after the war ended. Many documents are now being declassified, including something long rumored to exist: Camp X's secret training manual; the most comprehensive guide to espionage ever written.

**Camp X: Secret Agent School** explores the story of how this secret agent training school established in Canada during the Second World War and the training manual created specifically for it that laid the foundations for modern espionage in North America and gave birth to the CIA.
