The Western Development Museum - Saskatoon is pleased to have *Women's Hands Building A Nation* on display from the Chinook Guild of Fiber Arts (CGFA) through October 29, 2017. *Women's Hands Building A Nation*, is a non-juried fine craft exhibition, commemorating Canada's 150th birthday and is a collection of over 50 fiber art pieces celebrating Canadian women's accomplishments and contributions to Canada's growth as a nation. Topics such as the right to vote, women's progression of work, and specific women's achievements are featured.

The Chinook Guild of Fiber Arts (CGFA) is an organization with over 200 members and has been active in Calgary for over 85 years; previously known as the Alberta Handicraft Guild. Art forms include traditional rug hooking, quilting and needlework.
