I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure my child's care and custody prior to camp commencing and ending each day. I agree that neither the Western Development Museum, camp organizers, respective employees, agents, nor volunteers will be held liable for any injury to my child, and/or loss or damage to my child's personal property.

During their week at the Living History Young Pioneer Camp, participants are to comply with the three strike policy guidelines. This policy concerns children exhibiting excessively disruptive or violent behavior, including but not limited to verbal, emotional, or physical abuse of fellow participants, camp leaders, and personal or Museum property. Upon the first two times a child acts inappropriately, the child will receive verbal warning and the parent/guardian will be informed of the behavior. Upon a third incident's occurrence, the parent/guardian will be contacted and the child will be removed from the camp; there will be no refund of camp fees if this occurs. I understand this policy and the consequences of any inappropriate behavior on the part of my child.

The Living History Young Pioneer Camp organizers reserve the right to cancel the Camp due to the lack of funds, number of registrants, or any other reason at their discretion, and upon doing so, will refund registration fees. Camp organizers reserve the right to refuse further participation of any participant for rule infractions.
