## Living History Young Pioneer Camp Parent Handbook

### Registration

Registration is limited and campers are accepted on a first come, first served basis. A completed registration form, consent form and payment must be received to secure the child's spot in the camp. Children must be between the ages of 7 – 10.

### Payment

Payment may be made in person at the WDM Saskatoon Admissions counter or by phoning 306-931-1910. Methods of payment include cash, cheque, debit or credit card.

### Cancellation Policy

A \$40 administrative fee is retained for any camper withdrawing less than two weeks before camp begins. Any camper withdrawing more than two weeks before the camp begins is eligible for a full refund. Some exceptions may apply.

### Drop-off and Pick-up

Daily drop-off and pick-up will be outside of the Education room. Week 1 and Week 2 sessions run daily from 1:00 – 4:30 pm and the Week 3 session runs daily from 9:00 am – 4:30 pm. The parent/guardian will be required to sign the camper in and out each day. Please notify the camp leaders if anyone other than the parent/guardian will be picking the camper up during the week. If there is anyone who may NOT pick the camper up (ex. court order), please provide written notification of this on the first day of camp.

### Allergies/Medical Conditions

Please provide written instructions for camp leaders regarding any medical conditions, or medications required during camp.

### Confirmation

You will receive a confirmation letter via email on or before June 30. This letter will include a camp schedule or activities and a list of suggested camp clothes/supplies to send.

### **Camp Expectations**

- No touching artifacts in the Museum.
- Stay with the group at all times.
- No running inside the Museum.
- Listen to the camp leaders and volunteers
- Respect others (campers, leaders, volunteers, museum visitors) and property (supplies, Museum items, buildings)

### **Clothing/Camp Supplies**

- A small snack for an afternoon break
- Water bottle, sunscreen, hat, running shoes for outdoor adventures
- Please refrain from sending electronics (ipads, phones etc.) with your child. There will be a room for campers to store any backpacks and belongings they may bring, however the WDM is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- If applicable: Please provide written instructions for camp leaders regarding any medical conditions or medications required during camp.

### **Camp Activities**

Activities vary from year to year and a more detailed schedule will be sent closer to camp. A selection of past activities include:
