



TOUR BOOKINGS AT THE WDM SASKATOON

Group rates can be offered to groups of 10 or more who pre-book a visit to the WDM. These rates will only be honoured for groups that pre-book a minimum of one day in advance.

Group rates:

Adults \$9.50, Seniors (65+) \$8.50, Students (13 - 18 yrs) \$6.50, Children (6 - 12 yrs) \$3.50, Preschool (5 & under) Free when accompanied by an adult.

Preschool, Elementary and High School groups are asked to contact the WDM Saskatoon Education Department at 306-931-1910 or saskatoon.ed@wdm.ca to book and for special school pricing.

SELF-GUIDED TOURS: Groups on self-guided tours will be greeted by museum staff and provided with a gallery guide which contains a map of the museum galleries and descriptions of the various exhibits. Self-guided tours offer visitors the opportunity to tour at their own pace and focus in areas of particular interest to them. It is recommended that you allow yourself a minimum of 2 hours for a self-guided visit however groups are welcome to visit for shorter periods. French gallery guides/maps are available upon request.

SCAVENGER HUNTS: The WDM Saskatoon offers scavenger hunts for all ages at no additional cost. A scavenger hunt can be faxed or emailed to groups booking a self-guided visit. Groups are responsible for making copies for their group.

GUIDED TOURS: Group tours with a Museum volunteer can be arranged at no additional cost for groups aged 10 and up. Guided tours are not offered for children under age 10. Guided tours must be pre-booked a minimum of 2 weeks in advance. Guided tours are a minimum of 2 hours in length. Guided tours for children ages 10 and up will only be given if there are adult chaperones accompanying each group. Note that guided tours are only provided in English. It is recommended that groups not proficient in English register for the self-guided tour. Tours bookings can be made by calling 306-931-1910 or by email at saskatoon.ed@wdm.ca.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Daily, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm (from April through December)
Tuesday through Sunday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm (from January through March).

The Museum is closed on New Year's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day. Closed at 3:00 pm on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

The Museum Gift Shop is open during regular Museum hours. The Gift Shop provides of wide selection of Saskatchewan made products and souvenirs.

The Boomtown Café is open from 9:00 am - 4:30 pm during regular Museum hours. The Café has a seating capacity of 55 people. The Café offers weekday lunch specials and a soup of the day and is fully licensed. Reservations are not accepted.

The Museum has free, ample parking for Museum patrons and can accommodate RVs and buses.
