## Summer Heritage Club Parent Handbook

### Registration

Registration is limited and Club members are accepted on a first come, first served basis. A completed registration form, consent form and payment must be received to secure the child's spot in the Club. Children must be between the ages of 5-18.

### Payment

Payment may be made in person at the WDM Moose Jaw Visitor Services counter or by phoning 306-693-5989. Methods of payment include cash, cheque, debit or credit card.

### Cancellation Policy

A \$40 administrative fee is retained for any club member withdrawing less than two weeks before the Club begins. Any camper withdrawing more than two weeks before the Club begins is eligible for a full refund. Some exceptions may apply.

### Attendance

The Club member will be required to sign in and out each day that they attend a session or come independently to work on a challenge. Club members and their parent/guardian are required to wear their camp ID tags when in the Museum.

### Allergies/Medical Conditions

Please provide written instructions for Club leaders regarding any allergies, medical conditions, or medications required during camp.

### Confirmation

You will receive a confirmation letter via email within one week of registration. This letter will include a Club schedule or activities and a list of suggested clothes/supplies to send.



### **Club Expectations**

- No touching artifacts in the Museum.
  - Stay with the group at all times.
  - No running inside the Museum.
  - Listen to the Club leaders and volunteers
  - Backpacks, food and drinks are NOT allowed in the galleries.
- Respect others (Club members, leaders, volunteers, museum visitors) and property (supplies, Museum items, buildings)

### **Clothing/Camp Supplies**

- Water bottle, sunscreen, hat, running shoes for outdoor adventures
- Please refrain from sending electronics (iPads, phones etc.) with your child. There will be a room for Club members to store any backpacks and belongings they may bring, however the WDM is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Backpacks, food and drinks are NOT allowed in the galleries.
- If applicable: Please provide written instructions for camp leaders regarding any medical conditions or medications required.

### **Club Activities**

Activities vary from year to year and a more detailed schedule will be available to registered Club members. A full list and calendar of events will be available during Welcome Week. A selection of sample activities include:
