### Our Christmas 1910 Program changed in 2022. Please read the information in this document closely.

The WDM Saskatoon is pleased to invite applications for our Christmas 1910 program. During this program students learn about settler life in the early part of the 20th century.

#### Program Content:

- Before your visit, you will be provided with a video link to watch that is all about preparing for Christmas in Saskatchewan in 1910.
- At the Museum, a teacher-led imaginary shopping trip on Boomtown Street, learning about the types of gifts given during the holiday season and how much they cost, as well as a teacher-led tour of the *Eaton's Once Upon a Christmas* display identifying how it is old fashioned and different than what you would see today. Worksheets for these activities will be provided.
- After your Museum visit, you can discuss the outcomes of your worksheets. You will also be provided with instruction sheets and templates for three different Christmas-themed crafts you can do with your class.

Only one class will be able to book at a time so program space is limited.

Pre-registration is required. Classes will be registered on a first come, first served basis.

If your class is accepted, you will receive a letter of confirmation along with further information to help you and your students prepare for the program.



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**Program Cost:** Cost: \$3.50 per student

Chaperones must be provided at a ratio of 1 adult per 5 students. Chaperones are admitted free of charge. Support staff and chaperones for students with significant needs are allowed at a 1:1 ratio at no charge. Admission for additional adults beyond the required number is \$9.50 each.

Payment must be made in one lump sum at the Museum admission desk and a receipt will be issued. Please notify the Museum in advance if you wish to be invoiced.

**Educator In-Service:** An educator in-service session will be offered by request via Zoom. It will cover all aspects of the before visit activity, what to expect for your Museum visit and the after-visit crafts. You will also have an opportunity to ask any questions you might have.
