Program Availability: Museum Days takes place on the second Thursday and Friday of June.

Program Time and Length: There are four sessions available over two days. Morning sessions run between 9:30 - 11:30 am and afternoon sessions 12:30 - 2:30 pm. Note: Classes may only attend one session (morning OR afternoon) and are not permitted to stay at the Museum for the full day.

Program Cost: \$5 per student (Payment required at time of booking)

Chaperone Ratios: Groups are expected to provide chaperones (including teachers) at a ratio of 1 adult per 5 students. Chaperones are admitted free of charge. Support staff and chaperones for students with significant needs are allowed at a 1:1 ratio at no charge. Admission for additional adults beyond the required number is \$14 each. This charge may be applied to the purchaser's credit card at the time of arrival if payment has not been made in advance for extra chaperones.

Visiting with multiple classes: It is possible for multiple classes from the same school to participate in this program. Each class must book separately, but indicate their intention to visit together on their respective booking.
