



Our Health Benefits Plan and The Saskatchewan Special Support Program

Attached is an application form for the Saskatchewan Special Support Program for completion. The Saskatchewan Special Support Program is designed to help those whose drug costs are high in relation to their income. A family may qualify for special support based on their family's combined annual adjusted income.

In order to assist in controlling drug costs under our group insurance plan, Green Shield (the insurer for our EHC benefit) tracks family drug claims and contacts each plan member when the family's prescription drug claims have exceeded a certain amount. In order to continue paying drug claims, Green Shield requires a copy of the approval letter from the Saskatchewan Special Support Program confirming your deductible amount. If they do not receive this letter, future drug claims may be suspended.

A copy of your letter from Sask Health should be sent to the Curatorial Centre Administration office, who will forward it to Green Shield to have your account updated.

It is important to apply to the Saskatchewan Special Support Program, even if your drug costs are low, as it will help ensure that there is no disruption in the claims adjudication process with Green Shield. Proper co-ordination with the Saskatchewan Special Support Program will also assist in keeping the cost of the benefit program affordable.
