The Yorkton Threshermen's Club, along with the Yorkton Antique Auto Association and Western Development Museum, are excited to host the **68th Threshermen's Show & Seniors' Festival** on **August 1 & 2, 2026**. We invite you to participate as an exhibitor.

As an exhibitor at the **Threshermen's Show & Seniors' Festival**, you will have the opportunity to:

- Showcase your antique tractor(s) and meet other antique equipment enthusiasts.
- Participate in our Parade of Power taking place each day at 4:30 pm. Information from your registration form will be used by commentators during the parade. Be sure to include details about any restoration work, where you acquired the tractor, or other pertinent facts that make your entry unique. The Parade is weather dependent.
- Participate in the always popular 'Tractor Fun & Games' event.
- Compete for awards including Best Unrestored, Oldest Tractor, Furthest Distance Travelled, and People's Choice.

Please read the attached Rules for Safe Operation of Equipment which applies to events at all Western Development Museum locations. Thank you for your assistance and support.

Event Details:

- All tractors/equipment must be in place on the grounds prior to 11:00 am each day. [Tractors/equipment may arrive either the previous day or the morning of the event.]
- Upon arrival, gate attendants will direct Antique Tractor exhibitors to the back field area where exhibitors must check in at the BLUE TENT.
- For the safety of the public and exhibitors, tractors/equipment can only be removed from the grounds once the gates are closed for the day at 5:00 pm (after the parade).
- It is mandatory that any and all operators of tractors attend one Safety Briefing session each day (approximately 15 minutes). These are scheduled at 9:00 am and 11:00 am. Each operator attending will receive a coloured ribbon at the end of the session which must be worn and visible while operating equipment.

WDM Rules for Safe Operation of Visiting Vehicles

These rules are for the safety and enjoyment of everyone attending Western Development Museum events. Visiting vehicles includes, but is not limited to, tractors, automobiles, motorcycles, and horseless carriages.

1. Owners must complete and submit all necessary paperwork for themselves and their equipment **before** attending the event.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for the security, protection and insurance of their vehicles/equipment while on display and for any liabilities arising from its operation.
3. Vehicles/equipment must be in good repair and safe operating condition.
4. Vehicles/equipment must be in place on the grounds prior to event start. For the safety of the public and exhibitors, they can only be removed from the grounds once the gates are closed for the day. Vehicles may not leave the grounds during the event.
5. For the safety of all visitors and exhibitors, vehicles are not to be driven around the Museum grounds during the event. The only exceptions are when a vehicle is being moved into position for Museum sanctioned parades or activities (i.e. Turtle Races).
6. Owners may designate one or more individuals as operators for their vehicle/equipment. Each operator must sign their own Agreement & Waiver and, if relevant, provide proof of valid Driver's Licence for vehicle class.
7. All owners and operators must attend a Safety Meeting. This is mandatory. No vehicle/equipment may operate with an operator that has not attended.
8. Exhibitors are allowed to run their vehicles/engines while on display as long as they are not moving. Exhibitors must stay with their vehicles/equipment while the engine is running.
9. All exhibitors must provide their own fuel.
10. When fueling equipment, it should be shut down and cool.
11. Operators are responsible to ensure that their vehicle is secure when parked and can't roll away.
12. All vehicle operators must hold a valid Driver's License.
13. No person may operate a vehicle who:
 - while seated on the seat or standing on the platform, cannot push the brake or clutch down completely
 - while seated on the seat or standing on the platform, cannot pull or push the hand clutch or hand brake in or out completely as required to have full control.
14. Passengers are permitted in automobiles as long as both vehicle and passengers are in compliance with Saskatchewan laws.
15. Passengers will only be permitted on tractors with full fenders and a platform. Passengers are not permitted on fenders, drawbars or axles. Tractor operators and passengers must comply with the following:
 - Two people on one seat is not acceptable, regardless of age.
 - Passengers should be positioned behind the axle of the unit.
 - Children, under age 16, are only permitted to ride as a passenger on a tractor if a waiver has been signed by a parent or guardian.
16. All owners, operators, and passengers must agree to comply with Western Development Museum rules while participating in Museum events. The Western Development Museum reserves the right to refuse applications, equipment, operators, or passengers.

VISITING VEHICLE/EQUIPMENT EXHIBITOR **OWNER** AGREEMENT, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY FORM

Please read carefully and check each box to signify your agreement:

- Yes, I agree that as the owner of the vehicle(s)/equipment to be exhibited, I assume full responsibility to carry liability insurance and insure the vehicle against loss or damage at my sole cost. Damage to my vehicles or equipment while operated by its owner or anyone I have authorized to operate it, is my responsibility.
- Yes, I attest that the vehicle(s)/equipment to be exhibited is in good repair and safe operating condition.

I FURTHER UNDERTAKE TO HOLD AND SAVE HARMLESS and AGREE TO INDEMNIFY all the aforesaid from and against any and all liability incurred by and of all of them arising as a result or in any way connected to my participation in said event.
